Recycling Guidelines

Recycling is a state and local law. All cardboard, magazines, newspaper, junk mail, glass, aluminum and steel cans, plastic bottles numbers #1 or #2 must be recycled. They cannot be disposed of in your trash.

Paper and Cardboard

All residents now have Carts for paper and cardboard collection. The rules are as follows:

- Flatten cardboard, it can stick out the top of the cart. No cardboard will be collected unless it is in the cart. We have a recycling drop off at the Municipal building for large amounts or you can call the recycling hotline for a special pick-up for special things such as a move.
- Shredded paper can be put in a paper bag and then into the cart. No plastic bags in the cart.
- Place your cart in the street against the curb or at the edge of your property. An automated arm is collecting the carts. Place the cart with the lid opening facing the street. Keep the cart away from obstacles including recycling buckets, mail boxes and parked cars.

Plastic, Glass and Cans

- Place in your yellow recycling bucket and place at the curb

The following items are collected at the curbside by Burlington County:

- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum & steel food and beverage cans
- Empty aerosol cans (remove cap, leave nozzle)
- Plastic bottles only (must have a #1 or #2 symbol on bottom)
- Newspaper and Cardboard
- Pickup every other Friday, please refer to calendar
- Place at curb by 6 AM
- Mandatory for paper, cardboard, glass, metal and plastic
- Drop off center at Municipal building for the above and for used oil in containers and hazardous material (paints, solvents, etc.) in sealed containers
- Not recyclable – pizza/food boxes, window/broken glass, packing materials, eg. Styrofoam
